


## Faculty: Using Respondus Monitor for D2L Test Security

Note: Respondus Monitor only works for D2L quizzes (not other quizzes outside of the LMS. It must also be used in conjunction with the Respondus Lockdown Browser (that students can download from here).





- 1. Completely set up the D2L quiz (with questions, timing, date window, connection to grade item, etc.)
- 2. Navigate to the "quizzes" area and choose the "Lockdown Browser" minibar.
- You will see a listing of all the active quizzes.
   You will see if the lockdown browser (tier one) is required and if monitor (tier two) is required.






- 4. Choose the dropdown beside the name of the quiz and choose "modify settings".
- 5. Choose to "Require Respondus Lockdown Browser for this exam". You might also choose to "Require Lockdown Browser to view feedback and results," meaning that the student would have to using the lockdown browser to see the questions they missed, etc. after the exam (if you allow for that).
- 6. Choose "advanced settings" and choose to lock students into the exam until it is completed.





- 7. Choose to "Require Respondus Monitor for this exam".

  In the "start up sequence" choose to include the webcam check (by default) and the environment check and additional instructions.
- 8. Choose "Advanced Settings". Choose any specialized setting that are appropriate. (Save & Close)
- 9. The guiz should now have lockdown and monitor "required".



10. Beside the name of the quiz in D2L, you should see "Requires Respondus Lockdown Browser + Webcam". This means that the setting were properly configured.

11. When students take the exam, they will open up a regular browser first (Firefox, Chrome) and navigate to the quiz. They will then be prompted to "Launch the Lockdown Browser" (or download it if they have not already).
