


Students: Viewing Quiz Results/Questions after Exam Period

Depending on how the instructor devised the quiz, students may be able to see their grade/questions/answers to the exam after they submit the quiz. Students may be required to wait until a certain date/time to go back into their submissions to see those questions/answers. If students have already submitted the quiz and are referring back to it at a later time, here are the instructions for viewing the submission.

1. From the homepage, select the name of the course under “My Courses” (far right). Once you are within the course, select “Quizzes” from the navbar. You should then see the list of quizzes. Select the arrow by the name of the appropriate quiz and choose “Submissions.”

2. Depending on the setup of the quiz, you may be able to see your score for the quiz on the left side. You should be able to view all attempts. Most quizzes are set for students to take the quiz once, but some professors may allow for multiple attempts. Click on the attempt (ie: Attempt 1) that you would like to view.

3. You will then be able to see the questions/answers. Again, this is something that may differ based upon professor. Some professors may allow you to view the questions you answered incorrectly while some allow you to view those you answer correctly. Some allow you to see the correct answers while others only allow you to see the question. Some may allow you to see the answer you selected as well as the correct answer. Some also may allow you to see the points earned for that question (on the far left). This all depends on the instructor.
