

**AN AGREEMENT TO ESTABLISH A  
TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
GORDON STATE COLLEGE (GSC) and ALBANY TECHNICAL COLLEGE (ATC)**

**Agreement on Articulated Courses**

This agreement is specifically for students completing the courses included in this document at ATC who are transferring to complete a baccalaureate degree at GSC. This agreement does not apply to other institutions in the University System of Georgia. Any ATC student who completes the courses detailed herein at ATC, is in good standing at ATC, and meets the appropriate admission requirements to attend GSC will be ensured that the courses listed in this agreement earned at ATC will transfer to GSC.

**Acceptance of Transfer Credits at Gordon State College**

The following guidelines are used to award transfer credit toward a degree at GSC:

- College level courses transferred must be equivalent in content and standards to GSC courses.
- A minimum grade of "C" or above will be required for ENGL 1101 and any other courses designated by specific majors in accordance with their program requirements.
- No student may transfer more than 70% of the credit required for an associate or baccalaureate degree.
- Completion of an associate degree program ATC does not guarantee admission to GSC. Candidates must successfully meet all requirements for admission to GSC.
- Students who plan to change from a non-science major to a science major may need to take additional courses in Areas A-E.
