A Memorandum of Understanding between Gordon State College and Georgia Southwestern State University

Georgia Southwestern State University (GSW) agrees to offer acceptance into the Master of Business Administration (MBA) to students of Gordon State College who have completed appropriate degrees courses that lead to a BS in Management and Administration from Gordon State College. Georgia Southwestern State University and Gordon State College enter into this agreement to ease the transition between undergraduate and graduate matriculation and to allow graduates of Gordon State College the opportunity to remain in their communities and engage in employment opportunities while completing the Master of Business Administration degree online.

Gordon State College – Excellent business students who are interested in pursuing a graduate degree

Georgia Southwestern State University agrees to accept students who have completed the Bachelors of Science in Management and Administration degree at Gordon State College into our MBA program with minimal additional requirements. Any student who graduates from Gordon State College in business with at least a 3.25 cumulative GPA will be admitted to the MBA program as outlined below.

1. Requirement to submit GRE/GMAT scores will be waived;
2. Requirement to submit letters of reference will be waived;
3. Application fee will be waived;
4. Students may be admitted for any term – fall, spring or summer and are not required to be part of a cohort.

Gordon State College – Excellent students who are interested in pursuing a graduate degree but who do not have a business major

Georgia Southwestern State University agrees accept students who have completed any Bachelors degree at Gordon State College who wish to pursue a Masters of Business Administration into our MBA program with minimal additional requirements. Any student who graduates from Gordon State College with at least a 3.25 cumulative GPA will be admitted to the MBA program as outlined above, with the following

exception:

Students will be required to pass the following 4 prerequisite courses at Gordon State College with a minimum grade of C:

Gordon State College Course	GSW equivalent course
ACCT 2101, Principles of Accounting I (Financial Accounting)	ACCT 2101
MGNT 3341, Applied Statistics or equivalent	BUSA 3050
MGNT 3200, Financial Management or equivalent	BUSA 3150
MGNT 3000, Principles of Management	MGNT 3600

The terms of this agreement will be effective starting **03/04/2020** and will continue unless written notice of termination is given by either party one academic year in advance of termination.
