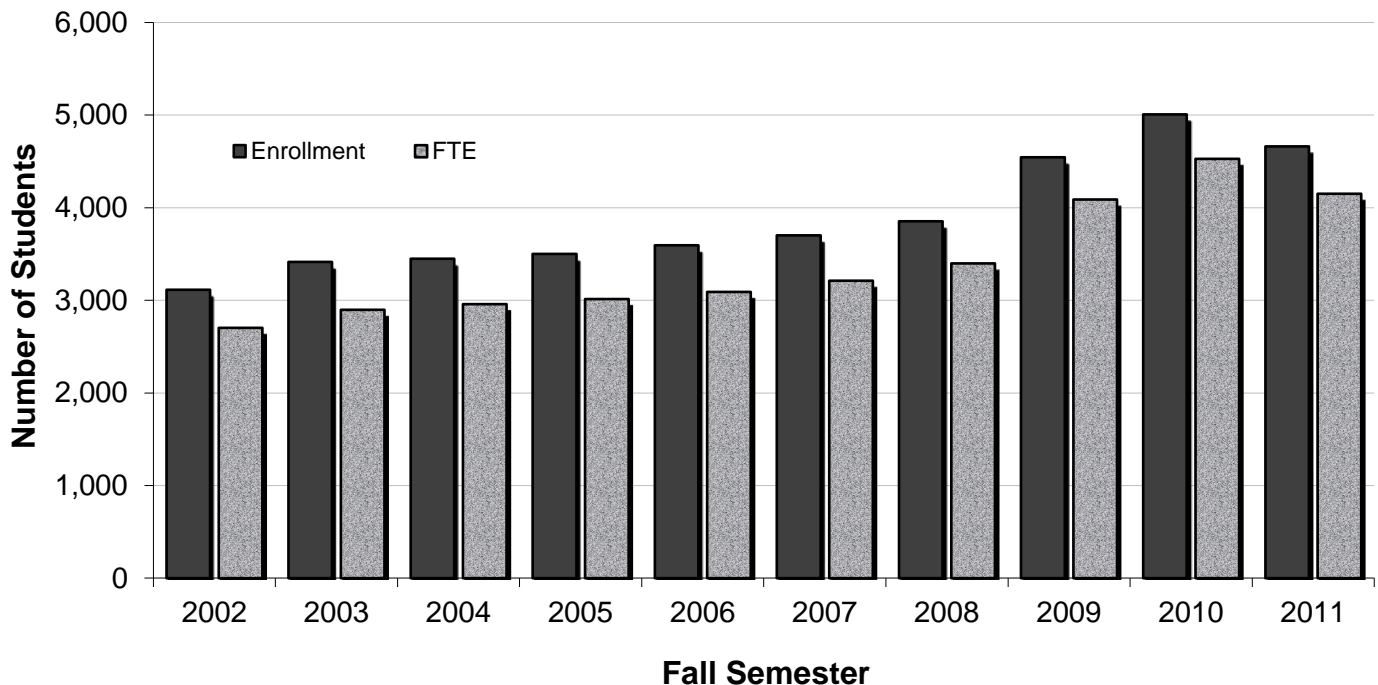

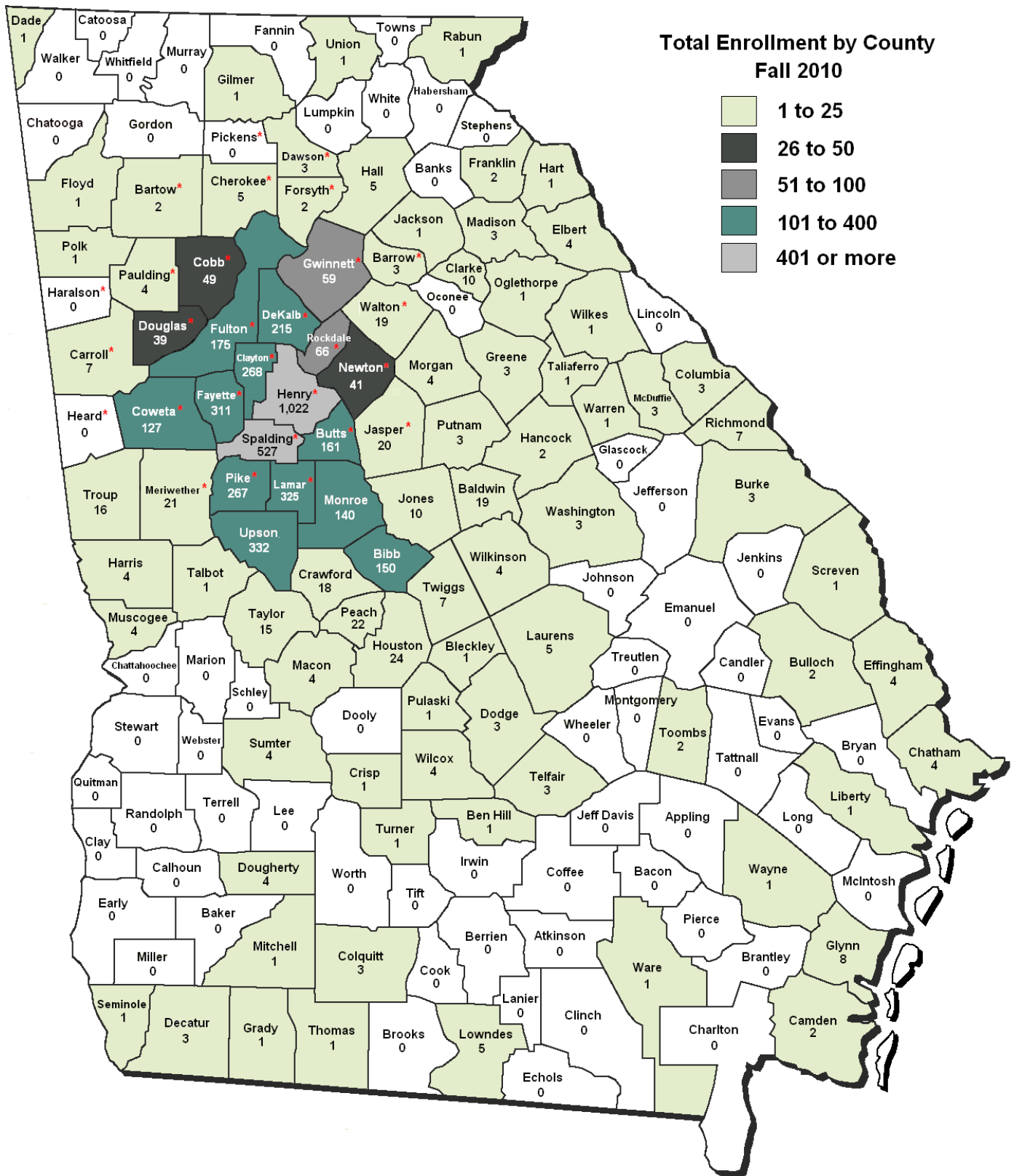

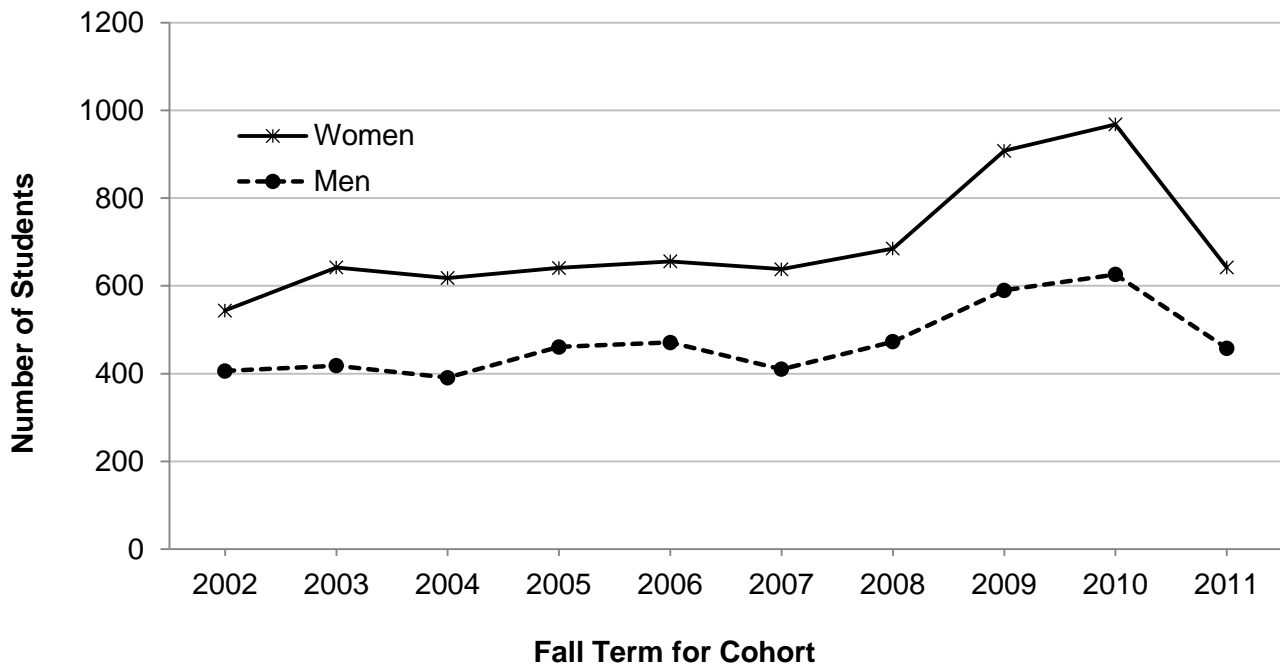

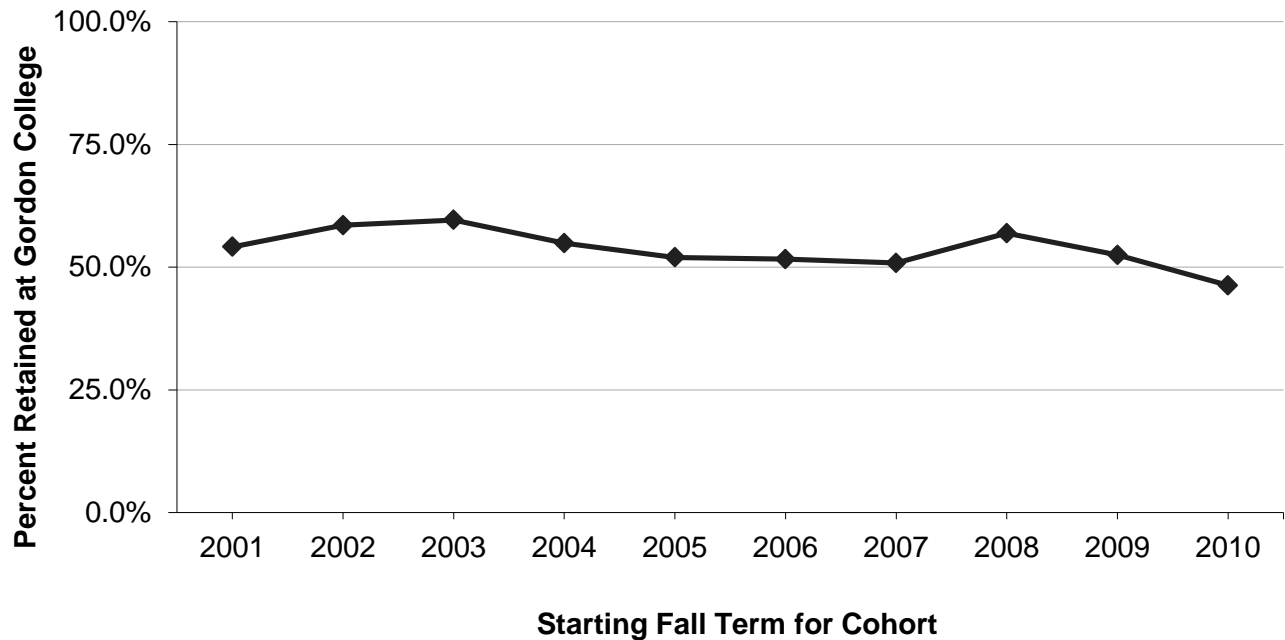

**First-Time Full-Time Freshmen One Year Retention Rates**

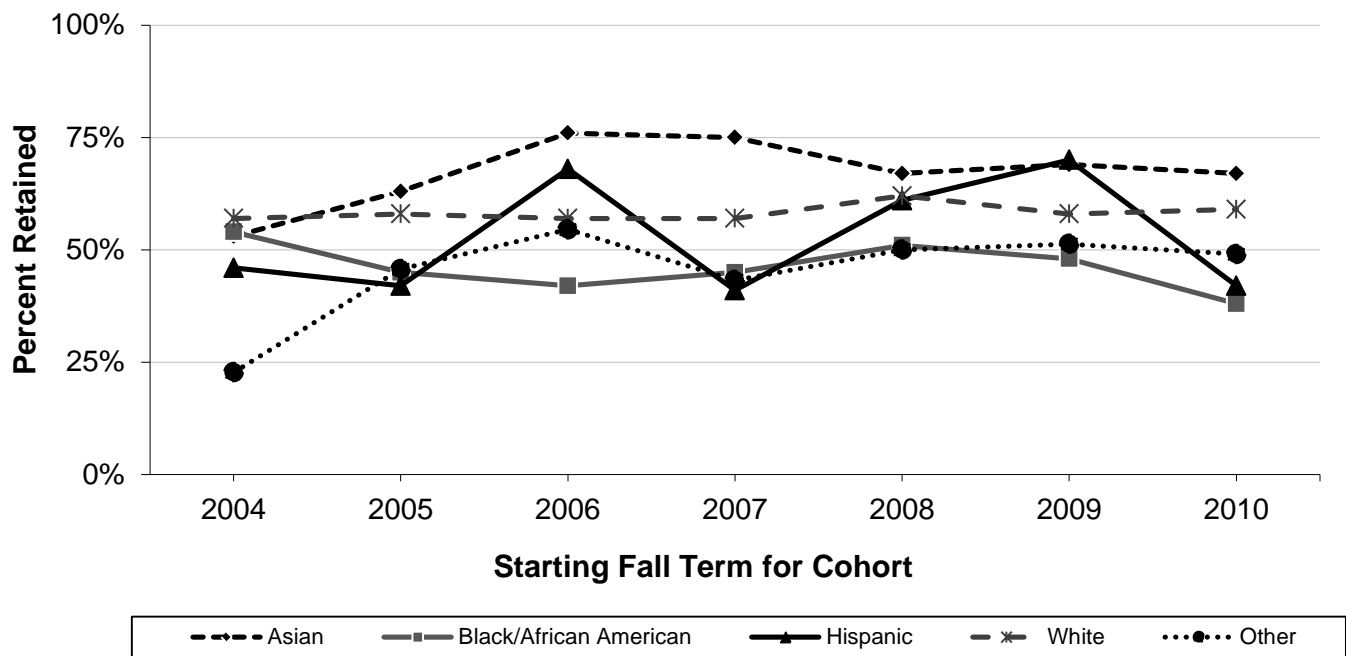

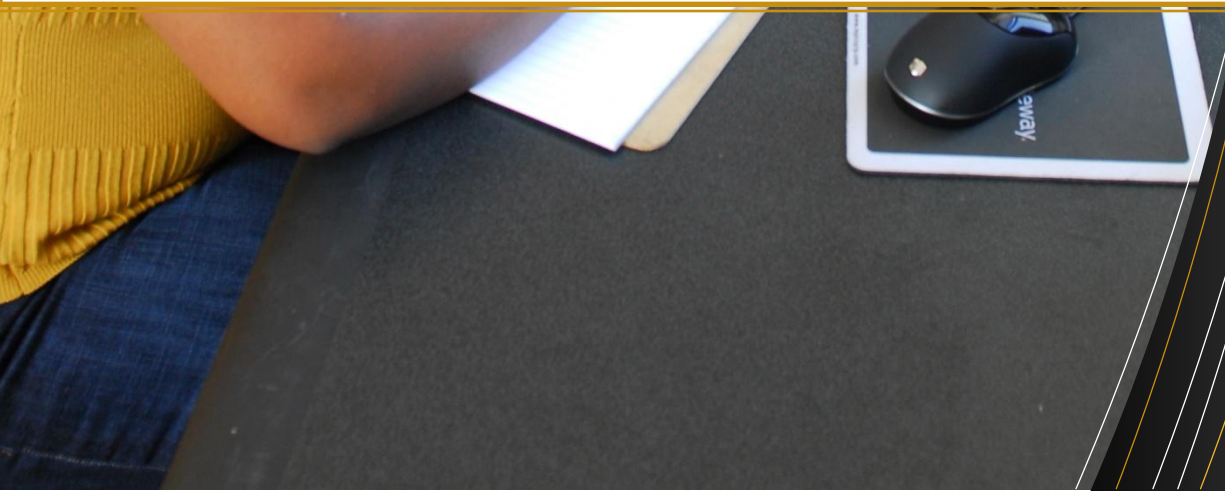

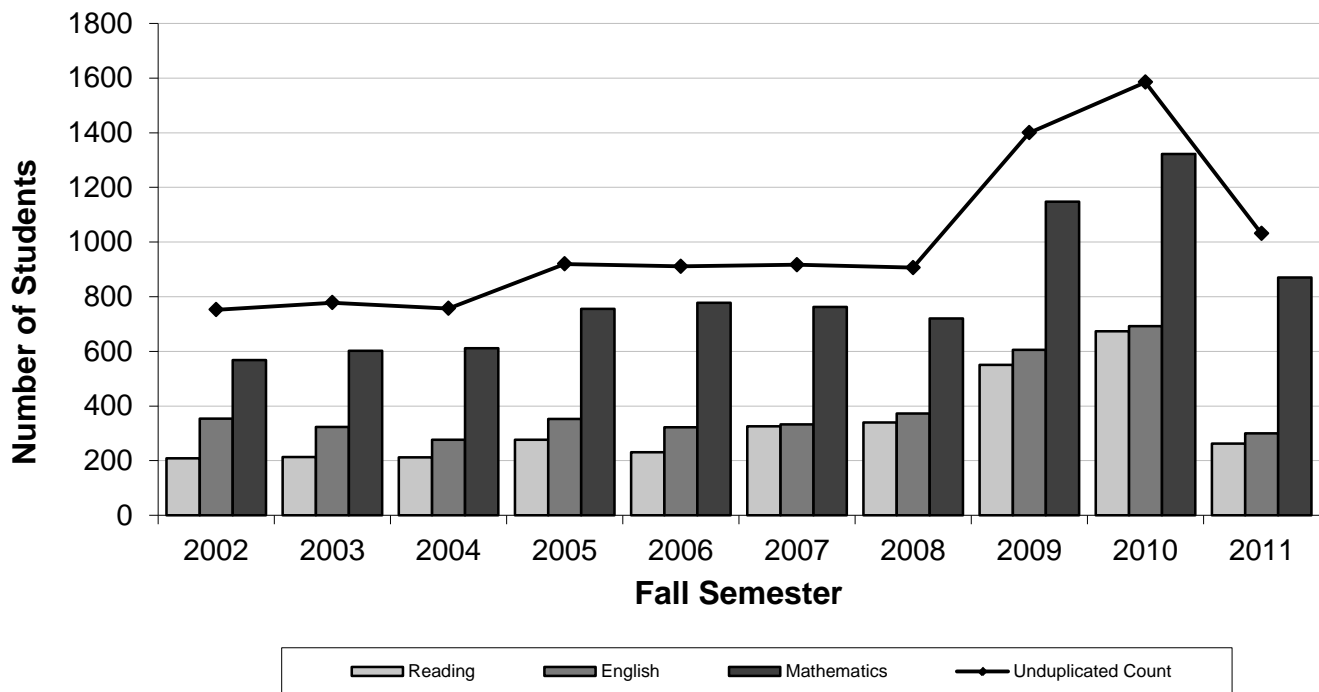
