

## Task Force on General Education Assessment Charge

Date: August 8, 2014

This Task Force is created to develop and implement the processes for assessment of the General Education (core) curriculum. Initial committee members were identified, but there is no expectation that they will become permanent members of this group without further review. Committee members will engage additional people such as representatives from Institutional Effectiveness/Institutional Research, Deans, Provost, etc. as needed.

The four key responsibilities of this initial group are:

- Oversee the assessment of the (General Education) core curriculum
- Work with the Faculty Senate Assessment Committee in achieving the GSC academic assessment for the 9 “Learning Goals” and review processes in accordance with the established timelines
- Follow the “New Program Outcomes and Student Learning Outcomes” approved by the Faculty Senate last semester
- Propose to the faculty senate that this Task Force should become a “Standing Committee of the College.”

At the end of the 2014-2015 academic year, the progress of the Task Force will be evaluated and next steps determined. It is hoped that this committee will become a permanent standing committee of the college. The composition of the committee will evolve over time.
